## **COMMUNITY NEWS**



### **OPERATION CHRISTMAS CHILD**

Samaritan's Purse, an organization founded by Franklin Graham, sponsors a program called Operation Christmas Child. OCC distributes shoeboxes filled with gifts to the neediest of children around the world. Children in war-torn countries, areas hit by natural disasters and children in closed countries are reached with the Gospel of Jesus Christ through this ministry. Before receiving the shoeboxes, the children are told the salvation message. They are then invited to attend a 12-week Bible study called the *Greatest Journey*. Upon completion of this course, a graduation service/party is held, and a New Testament is given to graduates in their language.

Now is a good time to start gathering items for the November 2018 collection. Watch for clearance items after Easter, winter clearance, etc. Some things we can use include hygiene items (NO liquids), non-violent toys (small stuffed animals are perfect), clothing, sports equipment, musical instruments, games, sewing kits, tool kits, fishing kits, and school supplies; no food items or seeds. Items should be new. Remember, they need to fit in a regular-sized shoe box.
